RE: CAMSHAFT ORDERS

To all M7RC Members and Associates,

The Committee of the Mini Seven Racing (M7RC) is aware that the process for obtaining/purchasing a Camshaft (as per M7RC Regs TR.5.7.1.5 vii, TR.5.7.1.6 vii, TR.5.7.1.7 vi and TR.5.7.1.8 vi) could be expanded upon and, to this end, we are aiming to revise the current system. The process will now be as follows:

1. The Member requests a Camshaft from the M7RC's MSA Technical Commissioner Mike Garton via email (m.garton@virgin.net) or via a phone call (01280-822464);
2. Mike will then provide the cost (including delivery) to the member;
3. Member to state their address and (if different) the full address for delivery;
4. Member to then agree to pay via a cheque, bank transfer or PayPal:
 - a. If by cheque, Mike will release the delivery once he receives the cheque. There is no flexibility here - the M7RC does not want to risk incurring bad debts;
 - b. If by bank transfer, Mike will release the delivery once he receives confirmation from M7RC Treasurer Jeffrey Parish that the payment has reached the M7RC account. To help this process, the member should copy Jeffrey in the communication (jeffrey@autograssreview.com);
 - c. If by PayPal (the M7RC's least preferred method), Mike will release the delivery once Jeffrey confirms the authorisation/confirmation of the PayPal transaction.

We hope you agree that this revised process will be helpful and we thank you in advance for your support in making it work,
