BULLETIN #1 2011 RE: DONINGTON PARK

To all Club Members and Associates,

Following the Donington Park race meeting held on Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 July 2011, for rounds 6 and 7 of the 2011 Dunlop Mini Challenges, the round 7 race results of both Mini Se7en and Mini Miglia respectively were amended:

- After post-race scrutineering for the second Mini Se7en event, car #46 Max Hunter was excluded from first position for being in contravention of Championship Regulation TR. 5.14.2 ["Technical non-compliance"]. This resulted in Championship Regulation SR.4.2.3 ["Additional specific championship penalties"] being applied by the Clerk of the Course, and a score of 0 (zero) being imposed for round 7, which the driver of Mini Se7en #46 Max Hunter will also have to count as one of his best 10 scores from the 13 rounds scheduled for the 2011 season.
- Following the second Mini Miglia race, car #11 Kane Astin was excluded from first position for being in contravention of MSA Specific Regulations for Circuit Racing Q.15.1.(k) ["Failure to comply with a black and orange flag"].
 - This resulted in Championship Regulation SR.4.2.3 ["Additional specific championship penalties"] being applied by the Clerk of the Course and a score of 0 (zero) being imposed for round 7, which the driver of Miglia #11 Kane Astin will also have to count as one of his best 10 scores from the 13 rounds scheduled for the 2011 season.
- All finishers on the amended race results for both Mini Se7en and Mini Miglia Challenges for round 7 moved up one position from those attained on the original round 7 race results.
- The original race results for rounds 6 of both Mini Se7en and Mini Miglia Challenges remained unchanged.
