CHAMPIONSHIP SPONSOR STICKERS

To all Competitors/Entrants,

Please note the following requirements as per the Regulations of the 2024 Dunlop Mini Challenges supported by Mini Spares:

With reference to TR.5.17 Numbers and Championship Identification (p19), further TR.5.18.13 (p22), TR.5.19.13 (p26), TR.5.20.13 (p29) and TR.5.21.14 (p31), it is a requirement of the championship regulations that sponsor stickers are carried on the cars in their correct locations at all times during the race meeting, importantly before scrutineering.

Therefore, in addition to the specific Dunlop/Mini Spares windscreen headers and door number panels for each class, the additional mandatory sponsor stickers for <u>Mini Spares</u>, <u>Piper Cams</u> and <u>Spax</u> are clearly indicated, along with the M7RC logos which, although optional, are freely available for you to help promote the Club's brand name.

All windscreen headers, door number panels and sponsor stickers, including the M7RC logos, are available pre-event from Mark Sims (email: <u>mss@clearsons.co.uk</u>) who can also provide an overnight postal service, or on special request can arrange for delivery to race meetings. In the case of damage/replacement during a race weekend, there may be a few spare sets of stickers/logos also available from the Club stand, but do not rely on this as Mike and Alan Jackson will have limited supplies on board.

The onus is on the competitor/entrant to ensure the above requirements are met, and any omissions at the next race meeting, Castle Combe on 21-22 September, will result in a non-compliance being issued, along with any subsequent penalties incurred.
